Please name all items of clothing, so we can determine the owner more easily.


If these items of clothing are not returned to their rightful owner by the end of each half-term, they will be given to charity or the Pre-Loved Uniform Shop.

Our NEW Headway Programme supports young women entering academic years 11 and 13 in September 2025 by offering the chance to:

- Learn about BAE Systems
- · Meet and shadow female staff
- Explore engineering and business services apprenticeships starting September 2026

Over six sessions from September to November 2025, participants will be matched with a BAE Systems mentor and visit Portsmouth Naval Base. They'll also meet current apprentices who'll share insights and advice.

We'll also guide participants through the apprenticeship application process, open from November 2025 to February 2026.
